Working with students in our foundation elements to Be Curious and Get Experience, there are a number of tools we use to encourage students in their career development pursuits.

Be Curious

Career Coaches

Coaches guide your path, providing support to students by asking questions, assisting with self-discovery, and providing advice. Frequent conversations are on résumés, interviewing, career planning, and job searching.

TypeFocus

An online career assessment for students to discover their personality type, interests, and values. Results help inform the decisions students will make regarding their careers.

VIA Character Strengths Survey

A scientifically validated assessment designed to identify and rank an individual's core character strengths, which can aid in personal development, goal setting, enhancing overall well-being, and finding language to describe yourself.

O*Net Interest Profiler

An online career assessment developed by the U.S. Department of Labor provides students with insight into their interests and matches them to potential career paths.

My Next Move

An intuitive online platform for students to explore various career options based on their interests, skills, and preferences. It offers detailed job descriptions, salary information, and potential career paths that are useful when making impactful decisions.
